It will be one of a series of tournaments run on Sundays at courses throughout western Minnesota. It is a great opportunity for both boys and girls of all ages.

Mini Junior Clinic

Age 4-6 (Beginners)

Our Mini Junior Clinic provides a brief introduction to the golf game for the beginner golfer. Instruction will include the long game, chipping, putting and a few rules. The last 1/2 hour of the 2nd day will be spent on the golf course where the junior will learn some basic rules and etiquette.

Junior Golf Camps (3 day camps)

Age 7-14 (All skill levels)

Our 3 day Junior Golf Camps provide a great opportunity for a Junior to build their golf game. These are also ideal for vacationing juniors who are visiting the area for just a week. One half hour of instruction begins each day, followed by 9 holes of golf. While on the golf course, juniors are encouraged to count their putts as well as their score so daily improvement can be recognized. Snacks are provided around 11:00 each day!

Junior Junior Golf

Age 5-9 (Beginners & Intermediate)

Our Junior Junior Golf clinic provides instruction for beginner and intermediate golfers between the ages of 5 and 9. The 2 hour sessions include instruction on the driving range, putting green and chipping area. Juniors are grouped by age and ability and will spend a portion of each session playing from 1-5 holes of golf on shortened holes at Lakeview, putting their instruction into practice. Juniors need to be able to carry their own equipment for a few holes of golf.

- Both sessions will be limited to 30 students.

Kate's Club (Girls only)

Age 5-14 (All skill levels)

Kate's Club is a girls only program on Mondays. Our goal is to get girls more involved in golf. As conflicts with swimming, vacation and Summer Theater arise, we will provide an alternative program for the girls so that they are golfing at least once a week. Instruction in the long game, chipping and putting will be followed by a few holes of golf on the shortened holes at Lakeview Golf Course. As in year's past, included in the fee will be a free entry into either a Wee Tee Tournament (ages 5-7) on Wednesday, August 10 or the Lakeview Junior Classic (ages 8-14) on Monday and Tuesday, August 8 & 9. The girls should be able to carry their own set of clubs when they go out to play on the course.

Sessions will be held on June 13, 20, 27 July 11, 18, & 25, no class 7/4 (rain date Aug 1)

Karter's Club

Age 8 -14 (Beginner - Intermediate)

Karter's Club provides junior golfers a fun opportunity to play with their peers. In addition to a 1/2 hour of instruction, the juniors will be paired with golfers of similar ability as they play from 5-9 holes of golf each week. Younger, intermediate golfers will play on shortened holes while the more advanced players will play from the forward tees. Progress will be charted throughout the summer with prizes awarded to the most improved. Weekly skill prizes will also be awarded. Juniors will be expected to carry their own clubs or they may rent a pull cart.

Thursdays 12:45-3:45 June 9, 16, 23, 30 July 7, &14. (Make up date on 7/21) \$80

The Player's Club(Intermediate & Advanced Ages 8-15)

The Player's Club is for competitive young golfers who want to play 9 or more holes every Friday from the men's & women's tees. One half hour of instruction will be followed by 9 holes of golf. Juniors will keep track of their score and progress will be charted throughout the summer. You must be pre-approved to participate in this program as it will be limited to 25 golfers.
